Balance Quest Checkerboard Puzzles are like jigsaw puzzles, but played with positive and negative numbers. They are designed for players who enjoy recreational math and logic puzzles like Sudoku.

Small Checkerboard Example Solution

Puzzle Rules:

- Using simple addition, fill in every shaded box, based on the sum of the numbers in the other shaded boxes as described in the bottom section.
- The dark shaded boxes contain the numbers from -8 to +8 (for small puzzles), or -16 to +16 (for large puzzles), except 0. The white boxes are empty.
- Leave no duplicate numbers in the light shaded boxes (including 0), or in the darker boxes, but numbers may be repeated between them.

Let's break down the left-most upper quadrant of this small puzzle.

In the above example, -2 is composed of 2 + -4.

In the example to the left, 2 is composed of -6 + 8.
