**About This List.** This list of 41 Grade 1 “service word” non-nouns first appeared in Dr. Edward Dolch’s 1948 book, *Problems in Reading*.

This list is useful for Grade 1 children and anyone learning English as a second language (ESL/EFL). There are other Dolch lists for pre-primer, primer, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. There is also a 95-word “Nouns” list.

Service words include connecting words such as “a”, “the”, and “and”, as well as common adjectives, adverbs, and so on.

Students should review the Dolch words until they are able to recognize them on sight.
