Concrete number–word pegs for fast memorization, compatible with the classic phonetic mapping.

Mapping: 0=S/Z • 1=T/D • 2=N • 3=M • 4=R • 5=L • 6=J/SH/CH • 7=K/G (hard) • 8=F/V • 9=P/B

How to use these pegs (quick):

- Convert digits → sounds (0 S/Z • 1 T/D • 2 N • 3 M • 4 R • 5 L • 6 J/SH/CH • 7 K/G • 8 F/V • 9 P/B).
- Peg long lists: treat pegs as list positions. For each number, combine its peg with your item in a vivid ACTION scene (e.g., #7 cow *kicks* a carton of eggs). Review 1→100 or backward.
- For long numbers: chunk into pairs (314159 → 31–41–59 → mat–rat–lip) and chain tiny scenes.
- Keep the same pegs for consistency; swap in alternates you love for stronger imagery.
